

Information for Photographers and Videographers

It is our joy to welcome you to Providence Baptist Church. We know you will play an important role in preserving memories for the bride and groom on their special day.

The wedding ceremony is not only a celebration of marriage, but also a service of worship. We therefore ask that you respect the following rules:

- Only time-exposure photographs (no flash) may be made during the ceremony. The photographer should be inconspicuous.
- After the ceremony, the wedding party may be reassembled for pictures in the Worship Center. Please take any pictures involving the pastor first.
- Videotaping may be done from the rear of the congregation or from stationary camera(s) placed at the sides of the church or in the choir loft.
- There should be no movement on the floor of the Worship Center during the wedding ceremony.
- All work should be done with good judgment and as unobtrusively as possible.

There will be a Providence Wedding Director at the rehearsal, wedding, and the reception if it is held on the church premises. If you have any questions, she will gladly assist you.
