Refinery Kickoff

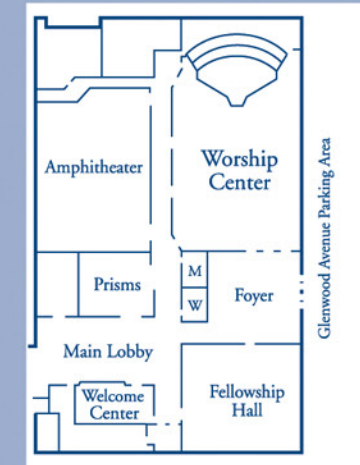
